The Temporary Cash Assistance Program

Temporary Cash Assistance (TCA) provides cash assistance to needy families with dependent children when available resources do not fully address the family's needs and prepares program participants for independence through work.

With few exceptions, most adults in a TCA household are required to participate in activities for 40-hours every week that help them find a job and lead a more independent lifestyle. The activities include work preparation, job readiness classes, independent and directed job search, unpaid work experience and community service placements.

Food Supplement Program

The Food Supplement Program helps low income people purchase the food they need for good health. People may be able to get assistance if they:

- Work for low wages,
- Are unemployed or work part-time,
- Receive other public assistance payments,
- Are elderly or disabled and live on a small income, or
- Are homeless

The Medicaid Program

The Medicaid Program (Medical Assistance) helps people access medical care and provides many medical and health related services for qualified individuals of all ages.

The TDAP Program

The Temporary Disability Benefit Program is for disabled adults (TDAP) and may be available to help low-income, disabled adults with no other resources. The program is funded through the State of Maryland to provide help to individuals without dependent children.
